From the North: Route 128 South to Exit 22-21B (Route 16 West – Grove Street); on ramp bear left and follow signs for Route 16 West; take right at end of ramp. Follow Route 16 for 2.9 miles through Newton Lower Falls, Wellesley Hills and Wellesley Center. *In Wellesley Center, Route 16 bears off to the left. Continue on Route 16 for 1.6 miles. Watch for Hunnewell Farm on right – entrance to Elm Bank is on left.*
From the South: Take Route 128 North to Route 135 exit (Dedham/Needham). Follow Route 135 West through Needham to Route 16 West in Wellesley Center. Follow directions highlighted above.
From the Mass Pike (heading East): Take Exit 13; after toll stay left to Route 30/Natick. At first light take right onto Speen Street. Stay left and follow signs to Route 9 East. Follow Route 9 East for 3.1 miles; pass Jarvis Appliance, St. James Church, and Mobil Station on right. Take right immediately after Mobil Station on to Weston Road. At end of ramp take a right. Follow Weston Road to light at bridge; go straight through light; follow to end of road and stop sign. Take right onto Route 16 West and go through light at Wellesley College. Watch for Hunnewell Farm on right – entrance to Elm Bank is on left.
